HAZARDOUS SUBSTANCE / PRODUCT DESIGNATION

Akemi transparent, Hardener
Contains: 2-Butanone, peroxide

DANGERS FOR HUMANS AND ENVIRONMENT**Corrosive****Oxidizing**

R 7: May cause fire. R 22: Harmful if swallowed. R 34: Causes burns.

Reactions with amines. Reactions with reducing agents, heavy metals. Reactions with acids. As oxidizing agent, attacks organic substances such as wood, paper, fats.

PROTECTIVE MEASURES, RULES OF CONDUCT

Use only in well-ventilated areas. Keep away from all sources of ignition - Refrain from smoking. Keep only in original container. Do not store together with reducing agents. Do not store together with acids. Do not store with combustible materials. Keep container tightly closed. Keep container in a well-ventilated place. Keep in a cool place. Protect from heat/overheating.

Ensure adequate ventilation on workstation. Safety glasses. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Do not inhale vapours.

Hand protection: PVA, >480 min (EN 374).

BEHAVIOR IN THE CASE OF A DANGER

Suitable extinguishing media: Carbon dioxide. Water spray jet. Dry powder. Foam.

Special protective equipment for firefighters: Use self-contained breathing apparatus.

Additional information: Fire residues and contaminated firefighting water must be disposed of in accordance within the local regulations.

Keep away from all sources of ignition. Ensure adequate ventilation.

Prevent spread over a wide area (e.g. by containment or oil barriers). Do not discharge into the drains/surface waters/groundwater.

Take up with absorbent material (e.g. general-purpose binder). Dispose of absorbed material in accordance within the regulations.

FIRST AID MEASURES

Ingestion: Consult a doctor immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Rinse out mouth and give plenty of water to drink.

Inhalation: Ensure supply of fresh air. In the event of symptoms seek for medical treatment.

Eye contact: In case of contact with eyes rinse thoroughly with plenty of water and seek medical advice.

Skin contact: In case of contact with skin wash off immediately with soap and water. Consult a doctor if skin irritation persists.

General information: Remove contaminated soaked clothing immediately and dispose of safely.

DISPOSAL CONSIDERATIONS

Disposal in an incineration plant in accordance with the regulations of the local authorities. Dispose of as hazardous waste. Packaging that cannot be cleaned should be disposed of as for product. Uncontaminated packaging may be taken for recycling.
