Irritating to eyes and skin. Possible risk of irreversible effects.

Reactions with strong alkalis and oxidizing agents.

PROTECTIVE MEASURES, RULES OF CONDUCT

Vacuuming in situ required. Avoid the formation and deposition of dust. Dust deposits that cannot be avoided must be taken up regularly. Keep only in original container. Do not store together with oxidizing agents. Do not store with alkalis. Keep container tightly closed. Keep container in a well-ventilated place. Protect from heat/overheating.

Ensure adequate ventilation on workstation. Breathing apparatus in the event of high concentrations. Short term: filter apparatus, combination filter A-P2. safety glasses Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Do not inhale vapours. Do not inhale dust.

Hand protection: Viton, >480 min (EN 374).

BEHAVIOR IN THE CASE OF A DANGERPhone: 

Suitable extinguishing media: Carbon dioxide. Water spray jet. Dry powder. Foam.

Use self-contained breathing apparatus. Do not inhale explosion and/or combustion gases.

Fire residues and contaminated firefighting water must be disposed of in accordance within the local regulations.

Take up mechanically. Avoid raising dust. Dispose of absorbed material in accordance within the regulations.

Use personal protective clothing. Ensure adequate ventilation.

Do not discharge into the drains/surface waters/groundwater.

FIRST AID MEASURESPhone: 

Ingestion: Consult a doctor immediately. Do not induce vomiting. Rinse out mouth and give plenty of water to drink.

Inhalation: Ensure supply of fresh air. In the event of symptoms seek for medical treatment.

Eye contact: In case of contact with eyes rinse thoroughly with plenty of water and seek medical advice.

Skin contact: In case of contact with skin wash off immediately with soap and water. Consult a doctor if skin irritation persists.

General information: Remove contaminated soaked clothing immediately and dispose of safely.

DISPOSAL CONSIDERATIONSPhone:

Dispose of as hazardous waste. Disposal in an incineration plant in accordance with the regulations of the local authorities. Packaging that cannot be cleaned should be disposed of as for product. Uncontaminated packaging may be taken for recycling.
